How about a DIY in prime Trophy Mule deer and elk! This gets even better, a semi-guided Trophy Deer hunt on the same ground that we conduct our Trophy Deer Hunts for only \$ 2495 and we even tell you where to hunt and take you there on horseback from camp and come back and get you in the evening!! For \$ 100 per day we add guiding for a total of \$500 for 5 days.!

Or if you want to lean back and let someone else do the driving and a 5 day guided with lodging pack in deer hunt with meals and lodging for \$ 4000 reduced down to only \$ 2995! Yea Baby !

This is a Trophy hunt in our normal area which has big bucks or if you draw the 1 in 90 tag for your license the bucks go up to 200 class bucks. In either unit we still have a low rate of only \$ 2995 for out 160 plus fully guided trophy hunt with meals and lodging. The general license is all that is required to hunt and they are available over the counter.

Big game hunting is offered in Idaho Fish & Game Units 66 (Tex Creek Zone) and 67(Palisades Zone). There is a lot of opportunity in these areas for Trophy Mule deer, Elk, Moose, Black Bear, Mountain Lion, and Predators.

Over-the-counter tags are available for General Elk and Deer hunts as well as Archery hunts in both units. Late season draw only hunts for Mule Deer provide an excellent opportunity for a nice buck.

General Mule Deer season is excellent in both of these areas also. Archery opportunity for a nice bull Elk is great in both of these units. General season tags are usually always available for Deer and Elk.

A non-resident Deer tag can be used for a Lion or Bear, if the opportunity arises. There is not a lot of hunting pressure during Archery and Muzzleloader season because of the terrain and road less status. Draw only Moose hunts also provide a great chance at a trophy bull. Please refer to Idaho Fish & Game regulations or website for all of the options available. Idaho is one of the few states that does not lower odds on licenses and hunting to the non-resident in any way. It is all and equal draw.

Semi-guided Hunts

We are offering a semi-guided hunt option which includes a fully equipped wall tent camp, a wrangler/guide in camp, horses in camp, how-to and hunt suggestions by wrangler/guide, hunting area suggestions, and one nice meal provided by wrangler/guide each evening, meat packing, etc.

Additional Info

Senior / Youth Hunt Prices

Youth hunts are available with any paying adult at the rate of one half price of regular hunt price. A youth hunter is 12-16 years old as shown on his/her current hunting license. A current Hunter Ed. Certification is also required. Price reduction is not available for license/tag/permit fees issued by Idaho Fish and Game. We welcome the young hunters. Hunters age 65 and older may deduct 10% off of the regular hunt prices. As the same for youth, license/tag/permit fees issued by Idaho Fish and Game are not included. Please refer to I.F. and G. Big Game Regulations for any questions

Non-Hunting Partner/Extra Days

A non-hunting partner is welcome at the rate of \$350.00 per day. Please let us know at booking if you are planning a non-hunting partner. Also, as needed and available, extra hunting days may be purchased at the rate of \$500.00 per person/day.

Hunt Information

All hunts usually will include 2 hunters/1 guide. There are hunts available at 1 hunter/1 guide. Meals included are breakfast, sack lunch and dinner. Lodging will be in comfortable heated wall tents. Camps will be accessed mostly by horseback. Drive to camps could be arranged also. Spike camps may be used on some hunts also. Hunt prices include care of trophy heads, (including local transport to a taxidermist), and transport of meat to a local meat processor.

*Hunts Do Not include the cost of meat processing, cost of taxidermy, alcohol, transportation to and from hunts, personal gear, etc..

Black Bear

Guided Spring Black Bear are offered during the month of May and the first week of June. Fall bear hunts are offered from August 30 through October 31. All of our bear hunts are conducted over bait and can be booked in conjunction with a fall elk or deer hunt. These Fall Bear hunts can be booked with archery or rifle hunts as a combo hunt. The Spring Bear hunts are a stand alone hunt. We can book Spring Bear or Fall Bear for any weapon over bait. These hunts produce some color phase and nice Idaho Black Bears.

Lion

The Lion Hunts are more of an incidental hunt where you might take a mountain lion during your elk, deer, or fall bear hunt. The area we hunt is not hunter friendly during the winter months and hunting lions in this area is difficult. Please call for more information on the lion hunts.

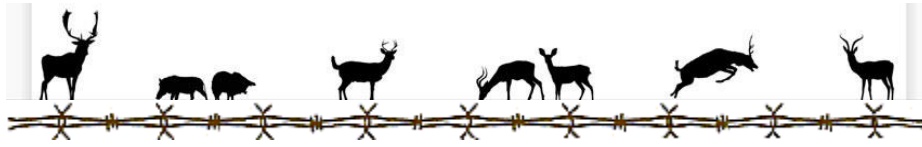
